About the programme

In a constantly changing world, it is essential for businesses to find ways to retain and develop their high-performing staff to help future-proof their business.

LELA offers organisations an ideal levy-funded and nationally recognized standard of excellence leadership development programme where participants can gain a level 7 apprenticeship qualification.

Throughout the 18-month programme, learners will gain practical leadership and management capabilities that they can apply immediately in the workplace.

By the end of the programme, learners will be:

- Independent and strategic thinkers with the ability to integrate knowledge within and across business disciplines
- Reflective practitioners with the skills to critically evaluate problems using appropriate concepts, theories and models
- Effective leaders who can integrate theory with experience to lead complex strategic organisational change appreciating the need for continuous professional development
- Innovative entrepreneurs who can realise opportunities and develop innovative strategies to solve problems and make strategic decisions
- Strategic communicators who can demonstrate cultural sensitivity and a willingness to solve problems involving teamwork and group activities within diverse environments
- Ethical leaders and socially responsible decision-makers

Who is it for?

The programme is suited for those working in management roles within an organisation, with responsibility for teams, people, budgets or other key areas of organisational accountability.

They must have at least three years of leadership experience. Learners do not require an undergraduate degree to participate in this programme.

How much does it cost?

The Leeds Executive Leadership Apprenticeship is open to businesses of all sizes. The programme is funded through the government's Apprenticeship Levy scheme, subject to eligibility and availability.

If you are part of a large company that pays the UK apprenticeship levy, the fees will be paid in full by the levy scheme. If you are an SME, contact Kristen Cabrera-Uhl to learn more about your funding options.

Programme overview

Programme structure

- 18-month programme
- Seven distinct learning blocks, each last eight weeks
- Each learning block concludes with an assessment: typically a 2,000 word written assignment
- Assignments are designed to be relevant to learners' personal work experience
- Portfolio of evidence compiled throughout course to support in final assessment
- Final external assessment overseen by CMI: a 4,000 word live business case relevant to the employee's own work

Commitments

- Participants require 20% of their time for 'Off the Job' learning time
- Not necessarily a day a week but time as required to learn, research, and shadow colleagues
- Commitment to attend all face-toface workshops, webinars and review meetings

Programme support

- Pre-induction manager/mentor meetings
- Dedicated skills coaches
- Study support sessions and online drop-ins
- Quarterly review meetings between each apprentice, their skills coach and mentor
- End point assessment workshops
- Dedicated learning platform

Application procedure

- Please complete the <u>application form</u>.
 This will be reviewed for eligibility and suitability.
- 2. View the commitments, expectations, and entry requirements for this programme.
- 3. You will be invited to upload various supporting documents to a secure portal.
- 4. Once all the paperwork has been uploaded you will be invited to a formal telephone interview.
- 5. A provisional offer of a place will only be made after a successful interview.
- 6. Your place on the programme will only be made available to you upon completion of the legal apprenticeship paperwork and procedures by your employer.

Fees

- The fees of £14,000 will be paid by your employer organisation through the UK Apprenticeship Levy Scheme, subject to eligibility and availability.
- If you are employed by a large company which pays the UK apprenticeship levy the fees will be paid in full by the levy scheme, once your employer has registered with the Digital Apprenticeship Portal and completed and signed the formal written contract with the University of Leeds. Your place will only be made available to you upon completion of the formal procedures.
- If you are employed by an SME, they can apply to reserve funding through the UK Apprenticeship levy scheme, but places are limited. The company will have to pay 5% of the cost of the fees. 95% of the fees will be paid in full by the levy scheme, once your employer has registered with the Digital Apprenticeship Portal and completed and signed the formal writte contract with the University of Leeds. Your place will only be made available to you upon completion of the formal procedures.

Programme at a glance

Intake	Multiple cohorts through the year
Application deadlines	Applications for each cohort are due at least 6 weeks before the start date. However, spaces are on a first-come, first-serve basis, so it is encouraged to apply early to guarantee your space.
Location	University of Leeds campus / online
Duration	18 months total (14 months taught and 4 months End Point Assessment)
Course fees	£14,000 per participant, funded by the Apprenticeship Levy. *Optional top up to Masters (MSc in Executive Leadership with additional £4,200 fees)
Entry requirements	A degree is not an essential requirement for entry on to the programme as there are different routes to apply:
	1. A First or Upper Second class honours degree (2:1), plus three years' management experience (with strong and consistent career progression and achievement)
	2. A Lower Second or Third class degree or equivalent professional qualification, plus five years' management experience (with strong and consistent career progression and achievement)
	3. No degree, but five years' management experience (with strong and consistent career progression and achievement). Non-standard entry assessment to be completed
	All routes require GCSE Maths and English at grade C or above or equivalent qualification
Professional experience	A minimum of 3 years' work experience in a leadership and management position
Accreditation	Level 7 Executive Leadership Apprenticeship, Chartered status with the Chartered Management Institute (CMI)
Delivery	Face-to-face workshops, group learning, reflective discussion, presentations, online tutorials one-to-one coaching, self-guided study
